### **Lynne Dominy Selected as Superintendent of Apostle Islands National Lakeshore**

**Omaha, Neb.** — National Park Service (NPS) Acting Midwest Regional Director Patricia Trap announced the selection of Lynne Dominy as superintendent of Apostle Islands National Lakeshore in Wisconsin. Dominy is currently the Chief of Interpretation & Education for Acadia National Park, Maine. She will assume her new role mid-March.

“Lynne is an exceptional leader who knows how to listen and foster collaboration both within and outside of government,” said Trap. “She will be a strong partner to the communities and the Lake Superior Ojibwa, and she will work with the outstanding NPS staff to continue taking the park in new directions.”

“I am honored to be selected for this important leadership position at Apostle Islands National Lakeshore,” says Dominy. “I have a deep passion for our nation’s water resources- our relationship to them for navigation, survival, recreation, and relaxation. I look forward to working with the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians and Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians, the communities who call this lake home, and with the park partners and staff who protect this beautiful park throughout the year.”

With over 30-years of experience with the National Park Service, Dominy has held numerous leadership positions. Since she started her career at Carlsbad Caverns National Park in the 1980s, she has served at Grand Canyon National Park, Point Reyes National Seashore, and Bandelier National Monument before moving to Acadia National Park in her current role. Dominy also served as the Acting Superintendent of at Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument where she worked closely with the Great Plains Indian nations and local communities.

Dominy graduated from Texas A&M University with a degree in park management. An avid kayaker, photographer, and swimmer, Dominy will be moving to the area with her dog Lilly. She is looking forward to enjoying the lake and trails and communities of the Chequamegon Bay area.
